General instructions:

- 1. The accuracy of the test results depends on the proper timing of the specimen collection.
- 2. Do not drink any alcohol during the 24 hours you are collecting the specimen.
- 3. Keep the jug with the urine that is collected in the **refrigerator**.
- 4. If you have any questions or concerns, call (877) 392-1234

To start the collection:

- 1. Empty your bladder. Do not save this urine, **FLUSH** this urine.
- 2. Write the start date and time on the jug label and below:

- 3. From then on, void urine into Specimen Collection Hat and pour **all** your urine in the jug provided, day and night. Rinse the collection hat with tap water after each use and allow to air dry.
- 4. If jug is getting full contact the lab for a second jug.

To finish the collection:

1. Exactly 24 hours after the date and time you started the collection, empty your bladder, and add this urine to the jug.

Example: If the urine collection was started at 9 a.m., the final urine would be collected and added to the jug at 9 a.m. the following day.

2. Write the date and time on the jug label and below:

3. Bring the jug(s) to the laboratory as soon as possible after finishing the 24-hour collection period.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

When dropping off the specimen, please ensure that you check with the **laboratory** staff. There are times when a blood sample is also required, or additional information is needed.
